

CROSS AND RECONCILIATION

EPHESIANS 2: 13-18: "For he is our peace, in his flesh he has made both groups into one and has broken down the dividing wall, that is, the hostility between us."

Dear Long Island Mar Thoma Church Members:

Greetings!

During these months, we observe Lent. So, our meditation, sermons, and prayers help us in fasting. Lent invites us to experience divine love and mercy as God accompanies us in our struggles. Our creator created us to worship him and honor him. But instead, we choose to eat and drink and come up with excuses not to honor the Lord. We'd rather amass wealth than turn to the Lord in prayer. We'd rather entertain our eyes with sensual images than conform to the commandments.

What is required is that we repent. Repentance is often misunderstood, but repenting simply means to change our minds, which involves turning away from sin and a turning towards God. Acts 3:19. explains: 'Repent, then, and turn to God, so that your sins may be wiped out, that times of refreshing may come from the Lord.' The promise for you and me is that if we repent, and turn to God, that our sins will not be counted against us, and we will receive Life. I pray that all of you have a meaningful lent, and may the God of Grace and Glory be with you and your families as you follow this Lenten path.

Ephesians 2:14 shows that 'Peace' must have its cost. Ephesians speaks about God's incomparable great power that brought about a great peace that broke the greatest barrier of all – sin. With this power, our great barrier-breaker – Jesus – caused the church to be born. He reconciled Jews and Gentiles both to God by His death on the cross. In one mighty sacrifice, Peace was secured, and the stronger party paid the price in full. Christ, our peace, who broke the wall of hostility, filled the gap with His broken body so that we can find this peace in Him alone. In His flesh, he

made our Peace, one new man – the Church. Outside of Christ, there is compromise and an agreement of sorts, but is there peace?

Jesus has entrusted the message of reconciliation to us (2 Corinthians 5:20). As ambassadors of Christ, we must entreat others to be reconciled to God. If Christ is the center of life, as we approach him individually, we immediately get closer to each other as all radii converge at the center of a circle. If there is a sequence in the process of reconciliation, it would be that we first approach Christ and then we will get drawn to each other.

We see that these are different types of activity when he lists a few: ministry, teaching, generosity, leadership, and compassion. He says, "We have gifts that differ" (Rom. 12:6a). It's called community. One of the antidotes you need in a selfish society is a church family, where you can belong and become and be what God wants you to be. As followers of Jesus, collaborating with others can help us make more of a kingdom impact.
